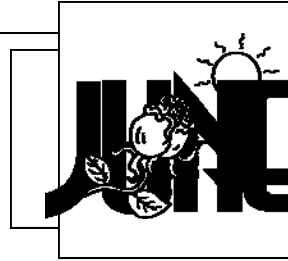

This is the same area that we had two flat tires back in March, but praise Father we DID NOT have ANY flat tires on this trip!

The end of the week we had the opportunity to travel with our supervisor to see wild elephants. We met up with some of our coworkers and some friends they met from the U.S. army, and they had a guide to find these elephants. We did not know if we would find them because after the first rain they start heading towards Burkina Faso (our neighboring country), but we found them. It was AMAZING! We saw between 90 and 100 wild elephants. At one point one of the elephants chased one of the vehicles, but it did not reach our car and everyone was safe. We had a great time and I have pictures to capture this magnificent event!

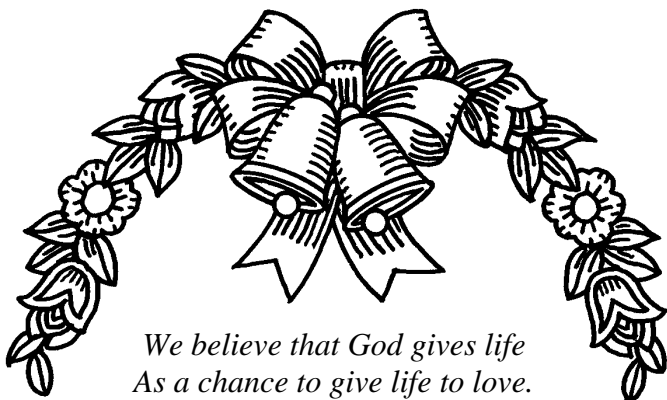

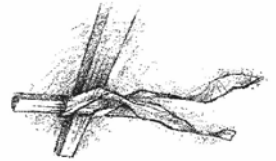

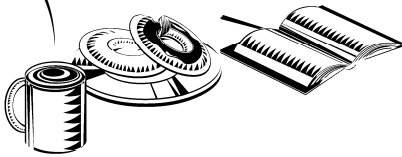
