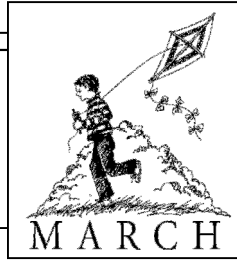

What a week! I had my first team this past week to take out to the bush, and it was my supervisor's home church from Texas! It was a 2 day drive out to where the people live, and we stayed 3 days. During our time there the people were extremely welcoming and loving. The first 2 days the guys got to tell stories to the men of the village outside of our compound at night, and the last day the ladies came in and our ladies were able to tell them stories, and they came back that night wanting to hear more. We found out that these people are really seeking answers, and the discussions we had with them about the stories really show they are wanting to know more. The Father is really working in that village, and it is amazing to watch and see. The first day our team went out prayer walking, and they found out that the pump in the village was not working and the water that the people were having to use from the well, was extremely dirty, causing a lot of people to be sick. The Father really spoke to our team and told them to help out. Through the local Pastor's help the team was able to fix the pump which was a real blessing, a really humbling experience. The people of the village were so extremely grateful, that they gave us 2 goats and 2 chickens, even though they had bad crops this year, and don't really have much to give. They gave what they had because of the relationship that was started with this trip.

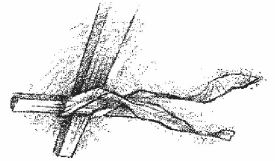
