Fall is here and everybody seems to be busy. Or maybe it is just me who seems to be busy. But I believe it is everybody.

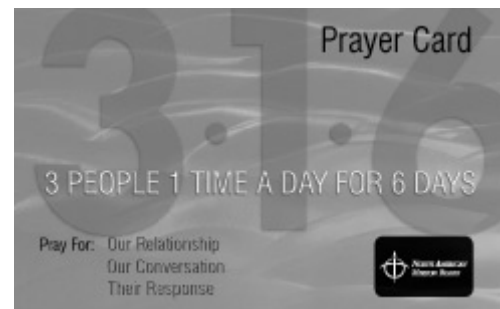

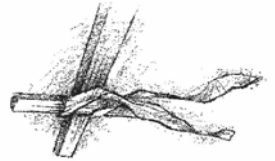

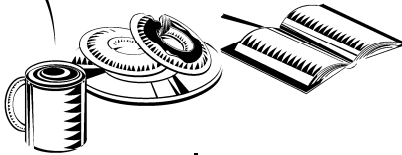
